Tech Tips IMovie Part 3 "Trailer": Sharing

Objective:

In this tutorial, we learn how to Save and Share this trailer to a trailer in iMovie. This is a Part 3 of 3 of a tutorial that will help you understand the basics of sharing a Trailer using iMovie App on an iPad

In part 2, we completed the outline and storyboard for the trailer, so now we need to save or share this with someone. The cool thing is that the project saves as it goes, but you may want to be able to share this with someone. To do this, we first need to get to the page to do this. Click the Back Arrow, < , located the top of the preview screen.

Once you click the arrow, the below page opens

Here we can play the video, by pressing the Play Icon, Upload the video, Trash the video project, and Edit the video.

Play Icon: By pressing the play Icon it will play the entire trailer on your iPad. If you have an apple TV, you can share the video over it to your projector, TV, or MondoPad.

Trash Icon: By pressing it, you are deleting the video





Edit Icon: Will take you back to the outline and storyboard so that you can make modifications to the trailer.



Upload Icon: Allows us to share the trailer by several ways. In addition to the basics, you may see additional locations you can share based on the Apps, you have downloaded on your iPad.

Basic Directions:

- Click the Upload Icon.
- From the popup Screen select the APP or tool and follow the directions. Each APP is a little different.



- AirDrop You can send the movie over Bluetooth connection to an another iPad that has AirDrop or to an iMac computer that is running OS X Yosemite on it. To check to see if your iMac has it on it.
 - Click the Apple located at the top of the screen and select About This Mac
