Project RED is arguably the most



Using DISRUPTIVE INNOVATION to Improve Schools New <u>Blended: Using Disruptive</u> <u>Innovation to Improve Schools</u>, by Michael B. Horn and Heather Staker A recommendation by Katrina Slone

This book gives a rationale for, and practical and interesting examples of, various ways to "blend" instruction in schools so that they truly become learner-centered institutions. While the focus is on opportunities to make foundational (thus

disruptive) changes in our outdated industrial system of education, the book offers a variety of models that range in their disruptive power while still allowing for more personalized and student driven learning. This is a great book that will cause you to begin playing out scenarios for rethinking how you "do school." I would suggest the e-book version as there are multiple videos embedded throughout that provide a first-hand look inside some of the disruptive opportunities described in the book.
