
How can you share a YouTube video and only the video? The answer is NicerTube, it removes the clutter from the Youtube Video that you want to share with your class or staff. If is free and you

New It's Not Rocket Science: 7 Game Changing Traits for Uncommon Success A recommendation by Katrina Slone

It's Not Rocket Science: 7 Game-Changing Traits for Uncommon Success by Mary Spio

This book was written by, basically, a rocket scientist! However, Mary Spio has done many other things. In the book, she describes her path from a "poster child for Save the Children" to a life as a rocket scientist, entrepreneur, successful business developer, and many other achievements. She uses her own life along with examples from many other fields to outline seven traits that she deems critical to success. This books is a good read for

administrators and teachers because it has great stand-alone examples that could be used in a classroom to inspire students (and grown-ups!). But I think it would be a great read for students as well. Mary Spio's story is interesting in itself and she uses examples from so many different areas and fields, that most students would find something they are drawn to and can relate to. Only one caution, while I usually love the audio version of books, this one is tedious because Mary Spio narrates it herself and she isn't a native English speaker. It is often hard to understand what she is saying. The print version, however, is just as full of inspiring stories and good solid common-sense advice for success in any field a student might choose. It isn't bad advice for adults, also, who are trying to reach a goal of their own.



New Bezel Maintanance & Precautions by Joseph Smith

Recently we had a problem at a school with a dusty bezel. Dust was prohibiting the cameras from seeing the location of touches, and therefore "touch" wasn't working. So remember to clean the touch bezel of the mondopad with

a soft cloth monthly. Be sure not to spray liquids into the bezel. It may damage the touch components.
