



Landscape VS Portrait


• Our eyes are horizontal, not vertical.







Rule of Thirds




Imagine breaking an image down into thirds (both horizontally and vertically) so that you have 9 parts.





Rule of Thirds



- 1. Placing points of interest in the intersections or along the lines makes your photos more balanced.
 - a. Studies have shown that people's eyes usually go to one of the intersection points most naturally rather than center frame.


Rule of Thirds (Grids)

IPhone -

- 1. Go to Settings
- 2. Scroll down to Camera settings
- 3. Enable grids

Android -

- 1. Go to Camera
- 2. Settings icon in top right
- 3. Scroll down to "Grid Lines" and select 3 x 3.





Rules are bound to be broken!

If you don't think your photo would benefit from the rule of thirds, don't use it.


Make it your own and have fun.





Focus


- Tap where you want your camera to focus.
 - The camera will automatically adjust the lighting and white white balance to wherever you tap.








Thumb in Front of Camera





Blurry/Shaky Photo

- Hold your camera as still as possible when taking a photo.
 - Especially in low-light settings, takes longer for the photo to process







Clean the Lens

- We all forget to clean our camera lens.
 - You'd be surprised the difference in the photos by a simple wipe of the lens.







Zoom in with your Feet

- Translates to walk closer to your subject.
 - Digital zoom
